Prof. Enrique Domínguez-Muñoz, the director at the department, is an internationally well-known expert in pancreatic function and pancreatic diseases. He has developed and optimized several pancreatic function tests, among them the ¹³C-mixed triglyceride breath test that is shown during the Masterclass. He is professor of Medicine at the University of Santiago de Compostela, Spain. He has been president of the Spanish Society of Gastroenterology (SEPD), (2008-2012) and of the Spanish Foundation of Gastroenterology, (2012-2014). He has been also Editor-in-Chief of the Spanish Journal of Gastroenterology. He has recently been elected as President of the European Pancreatic Club for 2024.
