Each element will be summed to provide a total for the grant requested. Please enter numbers only, as the funding will be made in GBP, please add in £ UK sterling values.
- 7. Ethical approval:** Please complete the ethical approval details or an ethics statement.
- 8. Institutional approval:** Please provide information to support your institutional approval, if relevant.
- 9. Declaration:** Please tick the declaration box to accept you will abide by the decisions and conditions of the PSGBI committee.
- 10. Head of Department:** Please provide the name and contact details of your Head of Department. Please complete this section even if the details have been entered earlier in the form.
